Ballymoney Nursery School Parent/Carer Covid-19 Agreement 2020/21



Everyone has a role to play in keeping our school safe and helping to stop the spread of COVID-19.

- Parents will ensure their child is well coming to school no temperature, no cough, no loss of smell or taste.
- > Parents will adhere to designated drop off point and time.
- > Parents will adhere to social distancing within the school grounds.
- > Parents will drop off their child and leave the school grounds promptly.
- > Parents give permission for their child to have their temperature taken each day on arrival at school and will take their child home if their temperature is high.
- Parents will remain outside the school building unless an appointment is made or their child is distressed.
- > If a child becomes unwell during the school day, parents will have specific arrangements that ensure their child is collected promptly from school.
- > If a child displays Covid-19 symptoms they should remain at home for the recommended isolation period (Currently 14days) or until they get a negative Covid-19 test result.
- > If a family member is isolating due Covid-19 symptoms, the child and other family members are required to self isolate for 14days before returning to school or on receipt of negative Covid-19 test results.
- > Parents/ Carers should inform the school if they, their child or anyone in the household are isolating with Covid-19 related symptoms.
- > Children cannot bring any toys from home.
- > Any medication that a child requires must be kept within school for the duration of the school year and appropriate medication forms completed.
- A spare change of clothes will be left in the nursery for your child at the beginning of the school year. If a child requires changing the staff will assist with this. The change of clothes <u>MUST</u> be returned_the following day so that there is a change of clothes for them if they need it again.
- > Parents where possible will make any payments to the school into the school bank account or by placing money/cheque into an envelope.
- > If parents take their children on holiday to a destination that has a quarantine period upon return, will ensure their child does not come back to nursery until the quarantine period has passed
- > If a child is isolating at home or the school closes due to governmental recommendations, parents will access Seesaw on a daily basis. Staff will provide activities via Seesaw to enable children to meet expected learning targets.
