Below are some activities that you could carry out with your child at home. The activities cover a variety of curricular areas that link with themes being covered in class.



<p>Play Dingle Dangle Scarecrow which can be found on Youtube: - https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=CtRgy-8Q0SE</p> <p>Sing along to it and do the actions</p>	<p>Watch Miss Johnston's Sticky Kids video that will be put on our private Facebook page on 16.10.20 and dance with her at home.</p>	<p>With an adult take part in a daily mile at home. This could be around your garden or where you live. Try and do fast walking and slow walking.</p>	<p>Listen to Five little pumpkin song on youtube and sing along with it</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=trDI36m9pgA</p>
<p>Go to the shop with an adult and choose a pumpkin. Ask the adult how they paid for the pumpkin, e.g. money or a card</p> 	<p>Draw a face on your pumpkin and ask an adult to carve the face for you. You can help scoop the insides out of the pumpkin.</p>	<p>Using the pumpkin that you have scooped out, you could make pumpkin soup with an adult!</p> <p>https://planningwithkids.com/2011/04/25/easy-pumpkin-soup-recipe/</p>	<p>Using what is left of the insides of the pumpkin, create your own potions and soup outside!</p>
<p>Go for an Autumn walk with an adult and discuss what you can see.</p> <p>Discuss the colours of the leaves, walk on them, jump on them, listen to the sound they make. What else can you see on the ground?</p> 	<p>Gather some leaves on your Autumn walk. At home, sort the leaves by putting all the same colours together; the same shape (type) of leaves together.</p>	<p>Gather other items on your walk e.g. conkers, pine cones, twigs. At home, create some transient (moveable) art. Make a picture with the items then move them and make another picture! You can also stick them down.</p>	<p>Punch holes in a leaf that you have collected and using wool or a shoe lace, thread in and out of the holes.</p> 
<p>With an adult, plant some bulbs (daffodil, bluebell, snowdrop, tulip) either in the ground or in a pot.
